

Prof. MUDr. Róbert Dankovčík, Ph.D., MPH

Prof. Dankovčík graduated from the Faculty of Medicine UPJŠ (FM UPJŠ) in Košice in 1992. Since then, he has been working at the Clinic of Gynaecology and Obstetrics of the FM UPJŠ, now as Deputy Head. In 1995, he passed his specialty board exam (Level 1) in Gynaecology and Obstetrics and in 2000 Level 2. In 2006, he was board-certified in Ultrasonography in Gynaecology and Obstetrics and in 2007 in Fetomaternal Medicine. Since 2003, he has been performing ultrasonographic diagnosis of congenital heart defects (supervisor Prof. MUDr. Jan Marek, Great Ormond Street Hospital, London). In 2002 as the first in Slovakia he received the Fetal Medicine Foundation Certificate of competence in screening Down syndrome in the first trimester. In 2004, he earned his Ph.D. title and in 2010 he habilitated at the FM UPJŠ.

In 2017, he inaugurated at the FM UPJŠ and became Professor of Obstetrics and Gynaecology. He is a member of the Slovak Society of Gynaecology and Obstetrics, the International Society of Ultrasound in Obstetrics and Gynaecology and he is the scientific secretary of the Slovak Society for Ultrasound in Medicine. So far, he has published 201 articles and has had 147 lectures at home and abroad.
