



Giovanni Coticchio, PhD.

Prof. Coticchio studied at the University of Palermo (Italy) where he was awarded a B.Sc. in Biological Sciences and a Ph.D. in Cell and Developmental Biology. He also studied at the University of Nottingham (UK), achieving a M.Med.Sci. in Assisted Reproduction Technologies. Whilst there, he held a clinical embryology position and developed research interests in human IVF as post-doctoral fellow. Later, as Head of research laboratory and senior embryologist, he joined Tecnobios Procreazione (Bologna, Italy), where he was crucial in the establishment of one of the first and most successful oocyte cryopreservation programmes. He was research supervisor at Biogenesi (Monza, Italy). Since 2018, he has been at the position of Scientific Director at the 9. Baby – Family and Fertility Center in Bologna. His primary research interests concern oocyte maturation and cryopreservation, oocyte-somatic cells interactions, and oocyte and embryo selection.

Dr. Coticchio has published over 71 original articles and reviews, co-authored 8 book chapters, edited 2 books, and has been an invited speaker or chief scientific officer at numerous international conferences and symposia. He is currently Chair-elect of the ESHRE SIG in Embryology.
