



**Prof. MVDr. Jiří Rubeš, PhD.**

Prof. Rubeš graduated from the University of Veterinary Medicine Brno in the Czech Republic in 1974. He completed his postgraduate studies at the Veterinary Research Institute Brno in 1984, and he received his second Ph.D. in Genetics from the University of Veterinary and Pharmaceutical Sciences Brno in 1998. He became Professor of genetics, animal breeding, and reproduction at the University of Veterinary and Pharmaceutical Sciences Brno in 2003. Currently, he is Research Group Leader of the Department of Genetics and Reproduction of the Veterinary Research Institute Brno, where he heads the research group of Clinical Genetics and Genotoxicology. He is Professor at the University of Veterinary and Pharmaceutical Sciences Brno and a member of the Scientific Board of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine of at the University of Veterinary and Pharmaceutical Sciences in Brno. His research activities and interests include human and animal genetics, especially molecular cytogenetics, reproductive medicine, especially human and animal andrology and genetic and reproductive toxicology. He is the author of 218 scientific papers (citations 2324; H-index: 23).
