



MUDr. David Rumpík, PhD.

Dr. Rumpík, Ph.D. graduated from the Faculty of Medicine, Masaryk University in Brno, Czech Republic in 1994. In 1997, he was board-certified (Level 1) in the field of Gynaecology and Obstetrics and in 2011 in the field of Reproductive Medicine. Over the years 1994-2000, he worked in the Teaching Hospital in Brno, 2nd Clinic of Gynaecology and Obstetrics, Department of Assisted Reproduction CAR II. In 2001, he established the Clinic of Reproductive Medicine and Gynaecology in Zlín where he holds the position of Director and IVF specialist. In 2018, he earned his Ph.D. title in the field of Gynaecology and Obstetrics from the Faculty of Medicine, Masaryk University in Brno.

In his professional practice he has been devoted for 26 years to infertility treatment through IVF methods including donor and surrogacy programmes. He belongs to the pioneers of surrogacy in the Czech Republic – in his Centre for Assisted Reproduction he boldly allows his patients to be treated for infertility in surrogate cycles. As a representative of the Czech Gynaecological - Obstetrical Society he was a member of the Board for Surrogacy Issues set up at the Ministry of Justice and he co-authored an official standpoint of the Section for Assisted Reproduction of the Czech Gynaecological – Obstetrical Society on surrogacy issues.

He is a member of ESHRE, ASRM and since 2013 he has been chairing the Section for Assisted Reproduction of the Czech Gynaecological – Obstetrical Society of the Czech Medical Association of J. E. Purkyně.
