



Peter Harbulák, M.D., Ph.D.

Dr. Harbulák graduated from the Faculty of Medicine, Comenius University in Bratislava in 1988. He worked as a physician at the University Hospital in Bratislava from 1989 to 2004; his professional interest focused particularly on infertility treatment, where he was a member of the Centre for Assisted Reproduction.

He repeatedly performed his internship throughout the years 1990 and 2000 at a French Clinique Mutualiste “La Sagesse” in Rennes.

In 2004 he founded GYN-FIV – Centre for Gynaecology, Urology and Assisted Reproduction – in Bratislava. Another affiliated branch of this centre was established in Nitra in 2015, and a new GYN-FIV centre was established in Žilina in 2017.

Dr. Harbulák is Chairman of the Assisted Reproduction Section at the Slovak Society of Gynaecology and Obstetrics, Head of the postgraduate study for the treatment of infertility at the Slovak Medical University, a professional guarantor and a committee member of international conferences.

His clinical and scientific work has long been devoted to studying the role of LH in ovarian stimulation protocols in IVF cycles. He is the author of several professional lectures and publications.
